engage.sewanee.edu/apply/status. Please note that your \$500 deposit is not an additional charge; it is applied directly to your total remaining cost of attendance.

MAKE A PAYMENT.

You may use Sewanee's Student Account Center (SAC) at Sewanee.afford.com to make a payment online. New students will receive more information about the SAC in early July when your billing statement for Advent Semester will become available. Your Advent Semester balance must be paid in full by July 31; your Easter Semester balance must be paid in full by Dec. 31.

OUTCOMES

Whether it's graduate school you're aiming for or a career you want to break into straightaway, the Office of Career and Leadership Development is here to assist you from the very beginning. Not very beginning as in the beginning of your senior year. Very beginning as in at the start of freshman orientation.

And from the very beginning, the Career and Leadership Development staff will encourage you to look into summer internships. Then, they'll tell you all about how they provide nearly \$460,000 to Sewanee students pursuing unpaid internships each summer. Career and Leadership Development also works with our students after graduation to see how they're faring in the "real world." Here's what they know about the Class of 2016:

- There were 398 graduates in the Class of 2016. We made contact with 99 percent of them within six months of graduation.
 - 73% are either employed full-time, in the military, or working in internships.
 - 12% are in graduate or professional school full-time
 - 8% received fellowships or are performing volunteer service
 - 2% are working part-time, or seeking employment or graduate programs
 - 1% did not respond
